PROPOSITION TO INCREASE THE LIMITING RATE FOR ROCHESTER PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Rochester Public Library District of Sangamon and Christian Counties, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 0.42% above the limiting rate for the purpose of the establishment, maintenance, and support of a public library for levy year 2023 and be equal to 0.671672 of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2024?

SUPPLEMENTAL BALLOT INFORMATION REQUIRED BY

35 ILCS 200/18-190
(1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$561,654.62 and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$1,498,965.65.
(2) For the 2024 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000.00 is estimated to be \$140.00.
(3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2024 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
